Advance Your Career with a Combined Master’s Degree and Dietetic Internship

Offered Jointly by Utah State University (USU) and Morrison Healthcare Dietetic Internship

A combined master’s degree and dietetic internship is now offered jointly with Utah State University (USU) and Morrison Healthcare Dietetic Internship. Students in this program are simultaneously enrolled in and complete all the requirements for a clinically focused dietetic internship with Morrison Healthcare while pursuing their graduate degree online through USU. The master’s program at USU focuses on leadership and management and provides value-added support for your clinical supervised practice experience. Students will earn a Master’s in Dietetics Administration (MDA). Students who successfully complete the internship and the graduate program will be awarded a verification statement from MHC, making them eligible to sit for the Registered Dietitian (RD) Exam.

Students will be awarded 9 graduate credits toward their master’s degree upon completion of their internship with Morrison Healthcare.

Program Format

This flexible online program is designed for busy and motivated graduate students. Fully asynchronous coursework allows you to balance academic demands with your internship rotations.

Total Graduate Credits: 31

Sample Schedule

- Summer 1: Complete 1 online course the last half of the summer semester (7 weeks).
- Fall: Complete three online courses (7 credits) while beginning supervised internship rotations with the Dietetic Internship. The Dietetics Career Essentials is a programmatic on-boarding course completed partially during the summer and prior to graduation.
- Spring: Continue your internship rotations while taking two online courses (6 credits).
- Summer 2: Conclude your MDA coursework with 2 online courses including the Master’s Project. (6 credits).

Upon completion of the final semester in August, students graduate from USU with the Master of Dietetics Administration (MDA) and receive their verification statement.

Internship rotations are arranged through Morrison Healthcare and are available at sites across the United States, offering flexibility and diverse clinical experiences.

USU Admissions Requirements:

- Graduate from an accredited nutrition/dietetics program with a DPD Verification Statement OR be in the process of completing an accredited nutrition/dietetics program and will receive a DPD Verification Statement or Foreign Dietitian Education program (FDE) upon completion.
- Applicants must have a DPD GPA of 3.0 or greater.
 - No Ds or Fs in any DPD/Prerequisite courses.
 - Approximately 400 hours of work or volunteer experience is required.
 - Applicants to the USU MDA must secure preceptors and training sites prior to applying.
 - Applicants must have technological competence.
 - Both a bachelor's degree and a DPD Verification Statement must be conferred prior to August 1st of the year a student plans to start the MDA.
 - The GRE is not required for admission.
- Application deadline for Summer 2027: **March 15**
- Complete online application and submit the following application elements:

 - Application fee payment
 - Statement of purpose
 - Unofficial transcripts
 - Official copies would be required upon acceptance
 - Language scores* (non-native English speakers)
 - Select the Summer Term
 - DICAS application (We will request this from Morrison Healthcare)

Tuition (2027-2028):

USU MDA Tuition: Utah State University offers competitive graduate tuition, and out-of-state fees are waived for distance learners. The cost is \$555 per graduate credit hour, totaling approximately \$12,210 for the required coursework (plus any applicable college or course-specific fees). Students also receive 9 graduate credits for their internship experience at no tuition cost. A \$50 per-credit review fee applies to those awarded credits, totaling \$450. Tuition is due on a semester-by-semester basis. Deposit to hold program placement: \$500, which will be applied to the first semester tuition.

Morrison Healthcare Dietetic Internship Tuition: Deposit to hold spot: \$2500, paid on acceptance into the MSFCS program; remainder tuition fee of \$8356, paid prior to rotations beginning in fall.
